

STANLEY CONSULTANTS' CHRONOLOGY

- 1913 – Charles Young founds Central States Engineering in Muscatine, Iowa.
- 1932 – C. Maxwell Stanley joins the two-person firm purchasing a 49 percent interest and assumes the duty of General Manager. The firm is renamed Young and Stanley, Inc.
- 1935 – The newly created Rural Electrification Administration leads to rapid growth as the firm plays an important role in electrifying the farms of the Midwest.
- 1938 – Young retires from the firm. Max Stanley becomes President.
- 1939 – The firm is renamed Stanley Engineering Company and has grown to 70 staff members.
- 1957 – The firm is awarded a contract to design a diesel power plant for an iron ore mine in Liberia, leading to the opening of the firm's first overseas office.
- 1961 – The firm becomes an employee-owned corporation. Henceforth, all employees are referred to as members.
- 1966 – The firm is renamed Stanley Consultants, Inc., to more accurately reflect the growing number of services provided.
- 1984 – Operations are extended to the Southwest with the acquisition of a Phoenix-based civil engineering and land-surveying firm.
- 1986 – Operations are extended to the Southeast with the acquisition of a West Palm Beach, Florida, firm specializing in land development/civil engineering, land surveying, and construction staking.
- 1991 – The firm is selected by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to design the reconstruction of the two Kuwait Air Bases destroyed during the Gulf War. More than 1,350 engineering firms vied for the project.
- 2002 – *CE News Magazine* ranks the firm as the country's Best Civil Engineering Firm to Work For.
- 2003 – The firm celebrates its 90th Anniversary.
- 2004 – As a part of the Stanley Baker Hill team, the firm is selected for a \$1.2 billion construction management contract for work in Iraq.
- 2005 – AARP names Stanley Consultants the nation's Best Employer for Workers Over 50.
- 2007 – Gayle Roberts, P.E., is elected President. The company has had just five presidents in 94 years.
- 2011 – *Engineering News-Record* (ENR) magazine ranks Stanley Consultants as No. 57 in the top 500 design firms in the U.S. and No. 106 in the top 200 international design firms.
